



JOHN F. HARANGODY

Director, Commodity Products

John F. Harangody was appointed Director, Commodity Products of CME Group in August 2007. He is responsible for defining the overall product strategy and tactics for CME Group's agricultural commodity products, as well as aggressively marketing those products to current and prospective CME Group customers. Previously, Harangody served as Director, Commodity Products of CME since 2003.

Before joining the company, Harangody acquired over 20 years of experience in financial services. From 1997-2003, he directed OTC cash grain product development and marketing for the ConAgra Foods Trade Group's risk management group, and he also served as the company's Manager of Risk Management Services. Harangody worked as Vice President for Rand Financial Services in Chicago from 1993-96, where he had oversight responsibility for the firm's risk management consulting and financial futures brokerage. Also in Chicago, Harangody served as managing Director, Derivative Products Group for Geldermann Incorporated from 1990-93, where he pioneered the first off-exchange agricultural options program in the United States. He was First Vice President for Drexel Burnham Lambert from 1982-1990.

Harangody began his career as a floor trader. He worked as a floor manager for Conti Commodities trading at the Chicago Board of Trade® (CBOT®) from 1978-1982 and served as a floor trader of options on futures at the CBOT from 1996-97. He has also lectured at Northwestern University.

He earned a bachelor's degree in management and marketing from Purdue University in 1974 and an MBA degree in finance from the University of Chicago in 1992.
